

What We Are Learning

ECA Second Grade

MONDAY

Domain: Domain will not start until Tuesday

Students will enjoy a picture book to practice expectations while learning on the carpet.



Vocabulary and questioning will be asked throughout the reading.

Skill:

Students will organize their materials in the skills block on the first day of school.

Math:

Students will play a get to know you game during the math block on the first day of school.

Question to Ask:

How can you SOAR on the carpet? **Answer: Answers may vary. Students can SOAR by sitting in their personal space, listening and facing the teacher, participating, raising their hand to speak, etc.**

TUESDAY

Domain: The Fisherman and His Wife

Students will make predictions about what magical powers may take place in this fairy tale.



Charming – very pleasing or appealing

Displeases – feeling unhappy or bothered about something

Enchanted – as if under a magic spell

Hesitated – stopped briefly before doing something

Might – power to do something; force or strength

Skill:

Students will explore images of geography terms and identify their names: bay, coast, harbor, canyon, valley, and many others.

Math:

Students will work on the pretest for the first semester.

Question to Ask:

The fisherman caught a flounder, but then let him go. Who did the flounder say he was? **Answer: The flounder said he was an enchanted prince under a spell.**

WEDNESDAY

Domain: The Emperor's New Clothes

Students will listen carefully to find out what the characters in this story pretend to know, and why the emperor is dressed in just his underwear.



Curious – having a desire to learn more about something

Ignorant – lacking knowledge or information

Inspect – to look carefully at something

Intelligent – able to easily learn or understand things

Skill:

Students will sort and match the geography images to the appropriate terms.

Math:

Students will work on the pretest for the first semester.

Question to Ask:

What do the characters in this story pretend to know or see? Why? **Answer: They pretend to see the emperor's new clothes because they do not want to seem like fools.**

THURSDAY

Domain: Beauty and the Beast, part 1

Students will make predictions about who the royal character in this fairy tale will be, Beauty or the beast.

Students will listen carefully to see if their predictions are correct.



Astonished – feeling or showing great surprise or amazement

Fearsome – causing fear or very frightening

Fortune – great wealth or riches

Merchant – someone who buys and sells goods

Skill:

Students will recreate and write about one of the geography terms.

Math:

Students will work on the pretest for the first semester.

Question to Ask:

How do you know that this story is a fairy tale? **Answer: It begins with the words 'once upon a time', there is magic, it is fiction, there is a royal character.**

FRIDAY

Domain: Beauty & The Beast, part 2

Students will predict if the merchant will return to the castle for his punishment or if one of the merchant's daughters will go in his place as we finish Beauty and the Beast.



Constant – happening all the time, over a long period of time

Despite – without being stopped; anyway

Determined – with strong feeling that you are going to do something

Sorrowful – feeling or showing great sadness

Skill:

Students will play a game to review all the geography terms.

Math:

Students will work on the pretest for the first semester.

Question to Ask:

What request does the beast grant, or give, Beauty after she decides to stay with him at his palace? **Answer: To go home and see her father.**
