#### **Graduation Tickets**

• Graduation ticket request forms have been distributed in Mrs. Cobb's leadership classes. Forms are due to be returned Wednesday, April 17. Students are guaranteed 20 tickets.

#### **Carowinds Trip**

The Carowinds trip should be a great time for all. The cost for the field trip is \$50.00 which includes park admission and transportation; students will need to bring spending money for food, souvenirs, etc. Our intention is to leave CCA early in order to arrive right as the park opens and return to CCA by 8pm.

## **Senior Awards Ceremony**

# **Graduation**

- Graduation will begin at 7:00 p.m. at Lawndale Baptist Church.
- Students must arrive between 5:30 6:00 at the Church. Students must be on time. If a student arrives after 6:00 p.m., they risk not being able to walk in graduation.
- Doors to the Worship Center will open at 6:00 p.m. Guests will be admitted at that time.
- There will be no saving of seats. Your entire party must be present to be seated.
- Graduation will be filmed by a team of videographers. Copies will be available. Details will follow.
- A reception will follow immediately in the Life Center at the Church. The reception will serve drinks and cake.
