Dear Cardinal Community:

Today, the Cornerstone Board of Directors held two emergency meetings to discuss Cornerstone's response to the National State of Emergency precipitated by the coronavirus.

In conjunction with the School administration, we have decided to revise the school calendar as follows:

- Monday, March 16, will be a teacher workday
- Tuesday, March 17, will be a regular school day for staff and students
- Wednesday, March 18 through Friday, March 20, will be teacher workdays
- The week of March 23 through March 27 will be Spring Break
- Friday, April 10, will be a holiday for students and staff.

The purpose of the regular school day on Tuesday, March 17, is to allow teachers to meet with students to discuss and distribute materials for at-home learning.

A special board meeting is planned for Monday, March 16, at 4:00 PM, at which point we will reassess the situation and make any necessary adjustments to the school calendar. We plan to meet at least twice each week to reassess the situation.

It will be very important for all parents and guardians to review forthcoming information from Mr. Caraher. He will be communicating with you regarding operational details such as Tuesday's arrival and dismissal procedures. His communications will also contain important information regarding the at-home learning materials that will be provided to your students.

This decision is difficult, but we are united in believing it is in the best interests of our students' health and education. We acknowledge the challenge that this change in schedule poses for our families, and appreciate your patience and understanding during this uncertain time.
