

Dress, grooming, and personal cleanliness standards contribute to the morale of all employees and affect the professional image of Brevard Academy-A Challenge Foundation Academy presents to its students, parents, clients and visitors.

During business hours, employees are expected to present a clean and neat appearance and to dress in business professional attire. Employees who appear for work inappropriately dressed may be sent home and directed to return to work in proper attire, and may face additional disciplinary action. Under such circumstances, employees will not be compensated for the time away from work.

Professional dress for gentlemen is business casual which includes dress slacks, collared shirts, and Brevard Academy apparel. Professional dress for ladies includes skirts, pants, skorts, dresses, women's business suits, and other business casual clothing. Dresses, skorts or skirts that are more than three inches above the knee are prohibited.

For all staff, denim jeans, cargo pants, shorts, t-shirts, sweat suits, , and clothing that in any way are tight or revealing are strictly prohibited. Approved BA-CFA t apparel or subject specific apparel is permissible. No flip-flops are permitted without a doctor's note for special requirements. Physical Education teachers and coaches may be attired in appropriate fitting shorts, t-shirts and sneakers during physical activity classes and sports practices.

Thursdays are reserved for public tours. This is a day for prospective parents to tour the building and observe educational programming. All staff should be dressed in business professional attire.
